BACKGROUND

Sachin Sarcoma Society (SSS) created Project Efficiency to address the issue of medication affordability for sarcoma patients. Unused, expensive medications due to disease progression or unfortunate circumstances like death result in significant wastage.

OBJECTIVE

Project Efficiency aims to reduce medication waste and help patients who cannot afford medications by organizing the donation and redistribution process. The initiative's goal is to provide a systematic way to redistribute unused but usable medications to those in need.

IMPLEMENTATION

- 1. Collection and Verification: SSS collects medications from willing donors, ensuring the medications are in proper condition, within their expiry date, and fit for use.
- 2. **Inventory Management**: The collected medications are cataloged and organized based on their type, dosage, and expiration dates.
- 3. **Identifying Recipients:** SSS identifies patients who require the specific medications. This is done through a thorough assessment of the patients' needs, prescription compatibility, and financial constraints.
- 4. **Distribution and Follow-up:** The medications are distributed to the selected recipients, accompanied by counseling and guidance on their usage.

- Implement measures to ensure the safe and secure handling of donated medications throughout the entire process.




LIMITATIONS


