

The "Non-Legislative Proposal" (PNL) for referring patients to specialized centers is approved in the Congress of Deputies.

**MARCH 2023** 

The protocol "Patient Experience with Sarcoma and Referral Protocols to CSUR" is released, highlighting the need to direct patients to centers specializing in sarcoma.



> "Sarcoma: Bringing the Invisible into Focus" seeks to educate and inform frontline healthcare providers, such as general practitioners, gynecologists, and pediatricians, about the symptoms and guidelines for the early detection of sarcoma.

This initiative, developed in collaboration with healthcare sectors across Spain, features contributions from a primary care physician, an expert oncologist, and our dedicated team.

Given that many healthcare professionals are unfamiliar with sarcoma and fail to detect it in time, this step is essential. Improving the survival rates of patients with sarcoma depends on early diagnosis, and at ASARGA, we are committed to making this a reality...





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
